Key dates:

- Application deadline: Monday, April 7, 2025
- Interviews of finalists will occur between April 14-30, 2025
- Awards will be presented at the Junior League of Savannah's General Membership Meeting on Monday, May 5, 2025.
- All applicants will be notified in writing of the Selection Committee's decision.

Application packet:

- Completed application form
- Volunteer letter of recommendation
- Student personal information essay
- A signed copy of the Minor Photo/Video Release Form

When images are published, the Junior League of Savannah and AJLI will take cautionary steps to provide minimum identifying information and will not use specific street or mailing addresses, email addresses, or phone numbers. Signed release forms are not needed when subjects are in public places, such as fairgrounds or parks. Photographs or videotaping in private or public schools or youth camps must be done only with the school or camp permission and with signed release forms for a parent or guardian of each child. Release forms should be included in school or camp registration materials. It is the responsibility of the photographer or videographer to obtain signed release forms and maintain records.
